Sun in Bharani Nakshatra

hen Sun is in Bharani Nakshatra aspected by Moon, the native is kind hearted. He has many servants.

When the Sun is aspected by Mars, the native is cruel by nature and expert at instigating conflicts between people. The native has red eyes and a strong physique.

When the Sun is aspected by Jupiter, the native is always ready to help others, is wealthy and politically prominent. He becomes highly educated and is a doctor or administrator.

When the Sun is aspected by Venus, one lives with mean people, is characterless, spends money on prostitutes and has many self-seeking friends.

When the Sun is aspected by Saturn, the native becomes lazy, undutiful, sickly and is a thief.

Sun in Bharani Padas

First Pada

The native is highly educated, progressive in thoughts, and has expertise in psychology and astrology. He is lucky, prosperous and principled

His personality is attractive and behavior is very kind

❖ He has a scar (sign of a wound) on his forehead or eyes. He may become a specialist in medical or animal sciences or law

❖ He can become successful in business when the Sun is at 15 or 16 degrees. He may deal in agricultural or hospitality products

Second Pada

The native enjoys a happy home life. He is blessed with a good wife and children.

He gains wealth through an inheritance or a windfall.

He may suffer with problems related to the throat or neck, sexual organs or abdomen.

He earns income through transportation or water-related goods.

When the Sun is at 18 or 19 degrees, the native may suffer from sexually transmitted diseases.

Third Pada

The native's life is full of struggle, but he will have immense wealth. However, due to improper use and bad habits, he will lose his wealth to others.

His major and sub-periods of the Sun go well, but other planetary major periods will give negative results.

In the Mars major period, injury to the head is possible. He will face business losses and income will be insufficient. Conversely, if Mars is well-placed and strong, he may benefit from landed property.

He is aggressive and impatient.

Fourth Pada

The native's childhood is spent in grief.

His father meets an early death.

If other planets are not helpful, then he will become a beggar.

If one or two planets are in a good position, then his/her situation will somewhat improve, though he will still be dependent on the support of others.

Moon in Bharani Padas

If the Moon is in Bharani Nakshatra and aspected by the Sun, the native will have a cruel temperament, but will still assist those in need. He may be punished by the law and will have fear of poison.

When the Moon is aspected by Mars, one may suffer from weapons, fire or paralysis. He will have diseases of his teeth and eyes. He will have to face many hardships, financial struggles and will be dependent on the support of others.

When the Moon is aspected by Mercury, the native becomes famous, learned, respected and wealthy.

When the Moon is aspected by Jupiter, the native is beloved by his employers. He will be helpful to their livelihood and faithful. He works as the representative of any big organization or state and will be blessed with good health and a happy, prosperous life.

When the Moon is aspected by Venus, one enjoys a good family life with his life partner. However, he does not receive full support from his progeny.

When aspected by Saturn, the native has the habit of abusing others and telling lies.

First Pada

The native becomes very wealthy and advances in life with the help of his siblings. He has a variety of vehicles and many servants. He has to face difficulties in religious activities due to impulsive financial investments.

The native thinks of today only and forgets about the future. Due to this attitude, he has financial hardships.

Second Pada

❖ The native's life is full of happiness. He receives help from his maternal family. He

may be adopted by them and receives advantages from them, especially from his grandfather

- He receives a higher education and enjoys the company of learned people. He has the opportunity to work with higher officers in his service period.

Third Pada

He marries twice. He receives recognition, respect and love from the common people. He helps those less fortunate.

He especially likes tobacco/paans². He earns a living through influential people, as well as gold, silver, ornaments, cotton and fertilizers.

Fourth Pada

The native's character is dubious. His behavior is mean, cunning and materialistic. He may repeatedly have accidents that lead to loss of limbs or other bodily harm.

Mars in Bharani Padas

When Mars is in Bharani Nakshatra and aspected by the Sun, the native is talented and intelligent, serves his parents and is in a respectable position among the wealthy.

When Mars is aspected by the Moon, the native is of bad character, is cruel, takes bribes and works in the army or treasury department.

When Mars is aspected by Mercury, the native is interested in the wealth of others, is characterless, melodramatic and follows the wrong path in life. He may be a thief or a smuggler.

When Mars is aspected by Jupiter, the native takes birth in a big family. He is the top achiever and highest earning member of his family. He becomes wealthy in middle life, though his nature is arrogant and callous.

When Mars is aspected by Venus, the native is fond of sweets and delicious food. His nature is selfish and materialistic, yet he is helpful to his family and society.

When Mars is aspected by Saturn, the native is forced to depart from his family or society. He is deprived of happiness from his mother. He has a weak body and is filled with feelings of revenge. He enjoys being a pariah, always at odds with his family and society.

First Pada

The life span of the native is around 50 years.

He meets with death in a foreign land or due to an accident along the way. Even very mild diseases affect his health.

He may be involved in vehicular accidents. He must refrain from narcotic drugs.

Second Pada

The native's body is delicate and his constitution weak, so he is unable to perform heavy work.
 He suffers from a variety of illnesses, yet, he is hard working and honest.
 He /she excels in education and in his profession
 He/she has strong attractions toward the opposite sex
 He/she suffers from sexually transmitted diseases
 He earns a living in the iron industry.

Third Pada

The native experiences negative results. He/she has to undergo great hardships before the age of 50 years, during which time he is dependent on others for a living.
 After 50 years of age, his life improves and he experiences happiness and prosperity.
 He/she lives up to the age of 84 years

Fourth Pada

The native earns the highest honor of state or country.
 He should be careful traveling in a foreign country, where he may meet his death due to an accident
 He earns fame and fortune by researching incurable diseases

Mercury in Bharani Padas

When Mercury is situated in Bharani Nakshatra and aspected by the Moon, the native is interested in music, acting and other related fine arts. He will enjoy the company of high-class women. He is blessed with fine homes, vehicles and servants

When Mercury is aspected by Mars, the native wins the favor of high-ranking government officials. With their assistance and support, he will earn great wealth, but he may become involved in some kind of conflict or difficulty with his work.

When Mercury is aspected by Jupiter, the native's life is full of happiness. He is blessed with an ideal wife and children.

When Mercury is aspected by Venus, the native associates with elite members of society. He is honored by family, friends and acquaintances

When Mercury is aspected by Saturn, the native will be immoral and cruel

First Pada

The native has a short lifespan.
 He experiences difficulties and distress in the periods of malefic planets
 The native earns through writing, teaching, priestly activity, and agency (like a middle man/broker kind of work) or by being a technical service provider

Second Pada

The native has a medium lifespan.
 He works on too many projects at one time and does not experience success in any of them
 He does not have a cordial relationship with his father and other relatives. Yet, he helps his family and relatives

Third Pada

The native has a long lifespan.
 He is blessed with a fortunate and a

highly educated wife who supports his progress.

He earns a living from small business or technical work

Fourth Pada

The native is in government service.

His lifespan is 45 years. He meets with death related to paralysis or other serious physical disease

Jupiter in Bharani Padas

When Jupiter is situated in Bharani Nakshatra and aspected by the Sun, the native is lucky, truthful, social worker and famous

When Jupiter is aspected by the Moon, the native respects his elders. He becomes famous at very young age because of his good deeds. He is of a content and peaceful nature

When Jupiter is aspected by Mars, the native may be callous and cruel. He frivolously spends money. He is able to dominate his employers. In middle age he becomes an administrator or performs work in an inspection field. Many people would work under him.

When Jupiter is aspected by Mercury, the native is not very truthful. He is a clever speaker and may be of a manipulative, divisive or quarrelsome nature. He becomes involved with several women at one time. His actions are phony.

When Jupiter is aspected by Venus, the native experiences much happiness. His wife is beautiful and impressive. He is fond of clothes and ornaments. He is blessed with fine homes, vehicles and servants.

When Jupiter is aspected by Saturn, the native does not know happiness and is miserable.

First Pada

The native becomes a good orator, is loved by his father and is the only support for his family.

He receives recognition and fame everywhere.

He has more than one wife.

He is employed at a high level within a business organization.

He suffers from neurological or mental illness and may be prone to accidents.

Second Pada

The native is blessed with sons and grandsons.

His lifespan is 55 or 60 years.

He is involved in criminal activities.

He pretends to be religious.

He earns money in a real estate or agricultural profession.

Third Pada

The native travels a great deal.

After 32 years of age, his life becomes happy and prosperous. He is a materialist.

He escapes from accidents many times in his life in very surprising ways.

He achieves well in competitive examinations.

He earns through taxes, law, gold, silver or the garment industry.

Fourth Pada

The native has a long lifespan.

He earns money through a food-related business. He is skilled in Tantra, Mantra and astrology. However, he is devious and may exploit others.

Venus in Bharani Padas

When Venus is in Bharani Nakshatra and aspected by the Sun, the native receives income from the government. He has specialized work skills. His married life is full of sorrow, and he must bear a great deal of stress due to his wife.

When Venus is aspected by the Moon, the native has an honored position in society.

However, due to his great attraction for the opposite sex, his character is flawed.

When Venus is aspected by Mars, the native is poor. His life is full of struggle at every step. His life is devoid of peace and happiness.

When Venus is aspected by Mercury, the native has to change his life path many times because of many hindrances. His life is not in accordance with his wishes.

When Venus is aspected by Jupiter, the native is famous and has an attractive personality. He is blessed with a fortunate wife and offspring. He experiences all types of happiness and material wealth.

When Venus is aspected by Saturn, the individual may keep stolen materials, or he steals the materials of others who entrust them to him. He is peaceful by nature and is respected among the people. He is filled with compassion.

First Pada

The native is skilled in music and poetry. He is a great orator, is incomparable in classical singing, eats little ("eats like a bird") and is famous.

He smokes a great deal. He has a scar near his forehead or near eyes. He becomes famous as an artist. He has enormous sensual desires. He earns through the business of musical instruments.

Second Pada

He is very attracted to women and suffers from sexual disorders or disease. His vision is weak. He earns through the business of feminine products or as a gynecologist.

Third Pada

The native is of short stature and sweet spoken. His wife is beautiful and socially skillful.

He is adept and dutiful in his work. He earns through communication, entertainment or media.

Fourth Pada

The native lives in a foreign land. He becomes a priest and performs yagnas and homams.

He becomes a chief of a religious organization and gains recognition in society.

Saturn in Bharani Padas³

When Saturn is in Bharani Nakshatra and aspected by the Sun, the native earns his living in an agricultural field, animal husbandry, or building construction. There is the possibility of his losing a limb in an accident.

When Saturn is aspected by the Moon, the native develops bad habits and traits in childhood, and is undutiful, cruel, merciless and poor. He works for criminals and is characterless and irreverent. He meets obstacles wherever he goes, is a thief and may be exiled from society.

When Saturn is aspected by Jupiter, the native is high state government officer. He is blessed with a beautiful wife and servants and is wealthy.

When Saturn is aspected by Venus, the native will travel far for his own recreation or in his official duties. He is of mean behavior, black colored, ugly and indulges in bad practices.

First Pada

The native takes part in religious work and earns money.

He lives in the company of intelligent & famous people and is a respected member of the society.

He has a scar on his forehead. He suffers because of surgery.

Second Pada

The native is intelligent, holds a high position in government and works in some capacity as an advisor
The native spends a happy life, though he may suffer from fevers. In the case of females, there may be reproductive illness or abortion.

Third Pada

The native remains dependent on others throughout life
He has two fathers or two mothers. One of them passes away in his childhood.
The native's life is baseless and devoid of material fulfillment.

Fourth Pada

This native is also totally dependent on others for his survival. He is disobedient by nature. At a young age, he may work in a military or law enforcement career. If Saturn is aspected by Mars, he becomes a dangerous thief or criminal.

Rahu in Bharani Padas⁴

First Pada

The native is honored by others. He is skillful at wrestling.
The native may receive large sums of money to protect or defend others.
His last part of life is full of disputes, and he may die due to malnutrition.
He may experience a serious illness from a dog bite.

Second Pada

The native receives high honor. He amasses

great wealth through his own efforts.

He may earn through a business related to vehicles.
He also earns through the business of selling animal flesh and skin. He suffers from leprosy.

Third Pada

The native becomes a famous poet or singer. Even if he is not highly educated, he still will earn the respect of high society due to his singing or poetic abilities.
The native also works as a military or police officer.

Fourth Pada

The native earns a living through oil or dairy products.
The native helps others, is wealthy and concentrated on his work.
The marital life remains unhappy.

Ketu in Bharani Padas⁶

First Pada

The native "takes food on lotus petals" i.e., he is wealthy.
If Ketu is aspected by benefic planets, his lifespan is shortened.
He spends his life as an educator who performs auspicious deeds.

Second Pada

The native lives up to 60-65 years of age. He suffers from waterborne diseases.

- ❖ He has injuries on his head or other parts of body. He may be prone to falls or other accidents.
- ❖ He suffers from mental imbalance or a brain illness. He is employed in some form of military service.
- ❖ Some of these natives may have weak eyesight, and some may engage in tantra-mantra practice for others.

Third Pada

- ❖ The native is well versed in Yogashastra.
- ❖ He may become a doctor or be somehow interested in the medical arts. He has knowledge of medicines as well as tantra-mantra. He understands himself as a servant of God and helps others.


Fourth Pada

- ❖ The native has a long life. He may become an architect or a building contractor.
- ❖ The native suffers from leprosy.
- ❖ He has broken teeth and may have an injury to his forehead.

Publishers Comments:

Many astrologers have avoided pursuing articles like the Ravana Samhita because the complex precepts are considerable and mostly untested. However, because village astrologers throughout India have sworn their faith and trust in the Ravana Samhita, we intend to reproduce many articles about it.

Let us take the example of Moon in Bharani nakshatra aspected by Mars. One is in a quandary to know how to interpret this placement. The commonly held interpretation is that this is a Lakshmi Yoga i.e. wealth combination! Not only that, but the Moon is in Aries near its exalted position in the favorable 11th house, which is another indication of wealth. However, the Ravana Samhita says that such a native will have financial struggles if aspected by Mars.

The chart below belongs to the late Dorothy Day, a social activist who founded the Catholic Worker Movement in 1933. Her life was nothing but struggle and is in fact categorized under "financial struggle" in AstroDatabank.

"The family moved to San Francisco when John took a job to write racetrack news, then was 'plunged into poverty' after the 1906 San Francisco earthquake which destroyed the newspaper plant. Still, they opened their home to worse-off neighbors, before eventually moving to Chicago."

Moon is in Bharani Nakshatra aspected straight by Mars from Libra thereby satisfying the condition laid out in Ravana Samhita that "she will have to face many hardships and will be dependent on the support of others." Further research is of course necessary to validate these principles.
